Being informed is a critical aspect of your personal disaster preparedness. Please sign up for the six information services listed below to be aware of changing local conditions.

<u>SoCoAlert online signup</u> - Sonoma County's emergency notification service (telephone, cell phone, text, emails). No resident should assume their information is in the system. Or, to register by phone call (866) 939-0911.

Nixle Alert online signup - Sonoma County Sheriff's emergency message system (email, text) important especially for evacuation warnings and orders. Or, text your zip code to 888777 to opt-in

PG&E Public Safety Power Shutoff Advisories - signup or call 1-866-743-6589.
